We had a routine start to the new year, which can be a good thing. That meant nothing eventful nor anything dramatic came up. However, we did continue to have new visitors and began a third service on Sundays going forward.

New third service

Starting on the first Sunday in January, we added a third service. Our first service always has been 2-3pm, Sunday School at 3-4pm, then now our prayer meeting is 4:30-5:30pm, which is the new third service. I wanted to set up a third service and a weekly prayer meeting for a long time, I'm glad we got to do it now. I believe that a prayerless church is powerless church, so this is something much needed.

Some people stay for the third service and some leave after Sunday School, which was expected. Some people go home to have dinner with their families, some have other obligations, and some work on Sunday nights. Since we have an afternoon service

and not in the morning like most churches, I wasn't sure when was the best time to insert a third service. I figured that since many of our people stay afterwards to chat, might as well make that time the prayer meeting. So far, many of our people like it. We begin by having a brief devotion on prayer, gather everyone's prayer requests, and then take turns praying.
